**Syllabus for Entrance Test 2078**

The candidate students shall attend the Entrance Test in order to be eligible for the enrollment in the desired course after they pass the test. The minimum pass marks for **Master and MPhil level will be 50% while for Bachelor level, it will be 40%**. It is mandatory to attend all the tests. For any reason, there is no provision of re-examination for the absent students. All types of tests will be conducted in **Virtual/Online Mode**, and there will be an orientation session on how to take them in this mode. The following are the types of tests and how they will be distributed:

**1. MPhil Level**

1.1 Specialization: MPhil in English Education, Nepali Education, Mathematics Education, Health Education & Education Studies

1.2. Examination Type: Written Test: 60% & Interview: 40%

<b>Research Methodology</b>	Research Methodology: Research Problem, Research Methods, Literature Review, Techniques/Tools of Data Collection, Population and Sampling, Data Analysis, Elements of Research Proposal, Research Report, Ethical Considerations
